## Mount Hoverla



Climb Mount Hoverla – Ukraine’s highest mountain and get a bird’s eye view of this beautiful land!

## Kosiv Bazaar



Take the chance to visit the famous Kosiv bazar and crafts market. Once a week on Saturdays, vendors and artisans come to Kosiv from villages in the area, to get together to buy and sell their wares.

## Pysanka Museum



Visit the world’s only Pysanka (Easter Egg) Museum, which houses a unique and rich -about 12, 000 Easter Eggs from different regions of Ukraine, and some from artists around the World.



## Kosiv Ceramic Factory



See the best examples of Kosiv ceramics. A tradition which arose in the 18th century, they use a unique blend of colours and techniques to create an instantly recognizable style.

## Hutsul Grazhda



Visit a traditional Hutsul house-fortress, or “Grazhda”. This is an impressive piece of architecture, preserved for centuries, and feels like you are stepping back in time!

## Pysanyj Kamin



Visit the ‘Pysanyj Kamin’ (Painted or Written Stone), a geological natural monument in Ukraine.

## Lizhnyky



Take the opportunity to visit the mountain village of Yavoriv. This village is famous for its unique, handmade woollen blankets, or ‘lizhnyky’.



## Woodcarver's Home



Visit a woodcarver's family. Passed down through generations, they engage in the ancient art of woodcarving and inlay. See their works, and try your hand at carving.

## Folk Instrument Workshop



Take a unique workshop with a famous craftsman and producer of Hutsul musical instruments – Mykhajlo Tafijchuk.
